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Limited Warranty

I. LIMITED WARRANTY & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Allen Engineering Corporation ("Allen") warrants its products to be free of defects in material or workmanship for: TWO YEARS FROM END USER'S DATE OF PURCHASE, SUBJECT TO THE EXCEPTIONS AND SHORTER WARRANTY PERIODS DESCRIBED HEREIN.



The warranty period begins on the date of purchase by the End User of the product. All warranty is based on the following limited warranty terms and conditions, including the disclaimer of all implied warranties of any type and the disclaimer of consequential damages.

1. Allen's obligation and liability under this warranty are limited to repairing or replacing parts if, after Allen's inspection, there is determined to be a defect in material or workmanship. Allen reserves the choice to repair or replace.
2. All warranty-related parts must be purchased in advance through an Allen dealer. The parts will be made available to the Allen Distributor, Dealer, or Rental Center from whom the End User purchased the product.
For machines being prepared, a warranty request form and/ or RGA request form must be submitted to AEC after the repairs are completed.
3. Replacement warranty parts, installed in the product, are warranted only for the remainder of the warranty period of the product as though they were the original parts.
4. BATTERY POWERED PRODUCTS ARE WARRANTED FOR ONE YEAR FROM END USER'S DATE OF PURCHASE.
5. Allen does not warranty engines or batteries. Engine warranty claims should be made directly to an authorized factory service center for the particular engine manufacturer. Batteries are not warranted due to unknown treatment during transport, etc., and any battery claims should be directed to the battery manufacturer.
6. Allen's warranty does not cover the normal maintenance of products or their components (such as engine tune-ups and oil & filter changes). The warranty also does not cover normal wear and tear items (such as belts, tires, blades, pans and other consumables).
7. Hydraulic Component's are required to be maintained per Allen's mandatory service intervals in each machines owners manual. OEM Allen hydraulic filters and consumables are required to service machines during the warranty period. Failure to use OEM Allen hydraulic filters will result in denied warranty.
8. Allen's warranty will be void if it is determined that the defect resulted from operator abuse, failure to perform normal maintenance on the product, modification to product, alterations, or repairs made to the product without the written approval of Allen. Allen specifically excludes from warranty any damage to any trowels resulting from a drop or impact to the rotors.
9. Impact damage to gearboxes is not covered under the Allen warranty and is deemed customer abuse.
10. Impact damage to trowels in any way is not covered under the Allen Warranty and is deemed customer abuse. (Example: Dropping a machine)
11. Allen will pay shop labor on warranty items at the Allen Shop Labor Rate in existence on the date of the warranty claim. An Allen labor chart will determine the time allowed to complete a repair and will govern the shop labor hours that will be allowed.
12. Allen will credit the cost of ground freight on warranty replacement parts after approval of the warranty claim. No warranty replacement parts will be shipped air-freight at the expense of Allen. Allen does not pay any inbound freight.
13. ALLEN ENGINEERING CORPORATION'S WARRANTY POLICY WILL NOT COVER THE FOLLOWING: TAXES; SHOP SUPPLIES; ENVIRONMENTAL SURCHARGES; AIR FREIGHT; TRAVEL TIME; LOSS OF TIME; INCONVENIENCE; LOSS OF RENTAL REVENUE; RENTAL COSTS OF EQUIPMENT USED TO REPLACE THE PRODUCT BEING REPAIRED; LOSS OF USE OF THE PRODUCT; COMMERCIAL LOSS; OR ANY OTHER CHARGES WHATSOEVER OR ANY LIABILITIES FOR DIRECT, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGE OR DELAY.

17. Once a warranty claim has been submitted, AEC has up to 90 business days to process the request.
18. Standard service part warranty will not exceed 90 days from the date of purchase. Exceptions to this are:
#1 Gearboxes: 1 year warranty from date of purchase.
#2 Electrical Components: 30 day warranty from date of purchase. This applies to wiring harnesses, transmitters, ECUs, display screens, and toggle switches.
19. All purchased components are subject to the inspection and warranty of the respective manufacturer. This inspection may extend beyond 90 days.
20. If warranty is suspected do not disassemble any hydraulic or electrical components. Failure to comply with this instruction will lead to denial of a warranty claim.







SAFETY**

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1.1.1 Safety-Alert Signs

This manual contains Safety-Alert Signs, as defined below, which must be followed to reduce the possibility of improper service damage to the equipment or personal injury. Read and follow all Safety-Alert Signs included in this manual.



NOTE defines an operating procedure, condition, etc. which is essential to highlight that contains useful or important information.



EMERGENCY is used for the identification of safety equipment, first aid, or emergency egress locations.



NOTICE used to convey safety information on labels and signs.



CAUTION is indicative of a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury.



WARNING indicates potentially hazardous situations that could result in death or serious injury



DANGER indicates an imminently hazardous situation which, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.

1.2.1 Laws Pertaining to Spark Arrestors

Some states require that in certain locations arrestors be used on internal combustion engines. A spark arrester is a device designed to prevent the discharge of spark or flames from the engine exhaust. It is often required when operating equipment on forested land to prevent the risk of fires. Consult the engine distributor or local authorities and make sure that you comply with regulations regarding spark arrestors.



CAUTION

- **NEVER** operate this equipment without proper protective clothing, safety glasses, respiratory protection, hearing protection, steel-toed boots and other protective devices required by the job or city and state regulations.



- Avoid wearing jewelry or loose fitting clothes that may get caught on the controls or moving parts as this can cause serious injury.

- **NEVER** operate this equipment when not feeling well due to fatigue, illness or when under medication.



- **NEVER** operate this equipment under the influence of drugs or alcohol.



- **ALWAYS** clear the work area of any debris, tools, etc. that would constitute a hazard while the equipment is in operation.
- No one other than the operator is to be in the working area when the equipment is in operation.
- **DO NOT** use the equipment for any purpose other than its intended purposes or applications.
- This equipment should only be operated by trained and qualified personnel 18 years of age and older.

1.3 - General Safety, continued

- **ALWAYS** know the location of the nearest fire extinguisher.



- **ALWAYS** know the location of the nearest first aid kit.



- **ALWAYS** know the location of the nearest phone or keep a phone on the job site. Also, know the phone numbers of the nearest ambulance, doctor and fire department. This information will be invaluable in the case of an emergency.



- Engine fuel exhaust gases contain very poisonous carbon monoxide. This gas is colorless and odorless, and can cause death if inhaled.
- The engine of this equipment requires an adequate free flow of cooling air. **NEVER** operate this equipment in any enclosed or narrow area where free flow of the air is restricted. If the air flow is restricted it will cause injury to people and property and serious damage to the equipment or engine.



- **NEVER** operate the equipment in an explosive atmosphere or near combustible materials. An explosion or fire could result causing severe bodily harm or even death.



- **ALWAYS** keep clear of rotating or moving parts while operating the trowel.



- **DO NOT** start or operate the trowel if the drive train will not disengage. Centrifugal force between the trowel and surface when starting can cause uncontrolled handle movement that can cause serious injury. The handle must not move while pulling the engine recoil starter.

- **NEVER** disconnect any emergency or safety devices. These devices are intended for operator safety. Disconnection of these devices can cause severe injury, bodily harm or even death. Disconnection of any of these devices will void all warranties.

CAUTION

- **NEVER** stand on trowel during operation.
- **NEVER** lubricate components or attempt service on a running machine.
- **NEVER** place your feet or hands inside the guard rings while starting or operating this equipment.

NOTE

- **ALWAYS** keep the machine in proper running condition.
- Fix damage to machine and replace any broken parts immediately.
- **ALWAYS** store equipment properly when it is not being used. Equipment should be stored in a clean, dry location out of the reach of children and unauthorized personnel.

1.4 - Engine Safety

WARNING

- **DO NOT** place hands or fingers inside engine compartment when engine is running.
- **NEVER** operate the engine with heat shields or guards removed.
- Keep fingers, hands hair and clothing away from all moving parts to prevent injury.
- **DO NOT** remove the radiator cap while the engine is hot. High pressure boiling water will gush out of the radiator and severely scald any persons in the general area of the trowel.
- **DO NOT** remove the engine oil drain plug while the engine is hot. Hot oil will gush out of the oil tank and severely scald any persons in the general area of the trowel.



CAUTION

- **NEVER** touch the hot exhaust manifold, muffler or cylinder. Allow these parts to cool before servicing equipment.
- **NEVER** run engine without an air filter or with a dirty air filter. Severe engine damage may occur. Service air filter frequently to prevent engine malfunction.
- **NEVER** tamper with the factory settings of the engine or engine governor. Damage to the engine or equipment can result if operating in speed ranges above the maximum allowable.
- **ALWAYS** use extreme caution when working with flammable liquids.
- **DO NOT** start the engine near spilled fuel or combustible fluids. Fuel is extremely flammable and its vapors can cause an explosion if ignited.
- **ALWAYS** refuel in a well-ventilated area, away from sparks and open flames.
- **NEVER** use fuel as a cleaning agent.
- **DO NOT** smoke around or near the equipment. Fire or explosion could result from fuel vapors or if fuel is spilled on a hot engine.

Familiarity and proper training are required for the safe operation of this equipment! Equipment operated properly or by untrained personnel can be dangerous! Read the operating instructions contained in both this manual and the engine manual and familiarize yourself with the location and proper use of all controls.

Safety Precautions


1. Read operating and safety instructions before using the High Pressure Sprayer. Operate the machine in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
2. Inspect your High Pressure Sprayer for damage or tampering that can sometimes occur during shipping.
3. If damage is found file a claim with your carrier immediately! Mark freight bill of lading as damaged shipment.
4. Do not operate High Pressure Sprayer if any guards have been removed
5. Only trained personnel should be allowed to operate your High Pressure Sprayer.
6. No foreign objects such as buckets, tools or materials should ever be attached to on the Sprayer during operation.
7. Do not attempt to fill fuel tank or oil sump while the engine is running. Allow engine to cool before refueling.
8. Do not use over the counter hardware to replace manufacturer's hardware.
9. **WARNING:** When operating machines with gas engines in confined areas. The fumes MUST be ventilated!
10. Always wear safety goggles, ear protection, and gloves when operating the High Pressure Sprayer.

SECTION 2: OPERATIONS

2.1.1 Assembly of Razorback® Power Sprayers to a barrel.

1. After you have uncrated all components received, place the sprayer (A) on top of the barrel. Using the barrel locks (B) supplied, fasten the sprayer to the barrel.
2. Take the suction tube (C) and the 5' X 3/4" hose (D) that is supplied and fasten together. Put the suction tube in the larger hole of the barrel. Connect opposite end of suction hose to the 3/4" QDC connector located on the sprayer.
3. Take the bypass tube (E) and the 5' X 1/2" hose (F) that is supplied and fasten together. Put the bypass tube in the smaller hole of the barrel. Connect opposite end of the bypass hose to the 1/2" QDC connector located directly below the flow control valve.
4. Locate the spray wand hose (G). This hose will be the longer of the three. Connect one end to the spray wand (H) and the opposite end to the 1/2" QDC connector located on the 90 degree elbow below the flow control valve on the sprayer.



2.1.2 Assembly of Razorback® Power Sprayers to a Push Cart.

1. After you uncrate all components received, place the sprayer (A) on the push cart (B). Use the fasteners provided to fasten the sprayer to the frame. If you are using a 9910 sprayer, you will need to remove the right hand side, handle to frame, brace (C) in order to place this sprayer onto the frame. After the 9910 sprayer is fastened to the frame, replace the brace. If you are using a 6500, 7560, or a 7560XL sprayer, this brace will not have to be removed.
2. Take the suction tube (D) and the 5' X 3/4" hose (E) that is supplied and fasten together. Put the suction tube in the larger hole of the barrel. Connect opposite end of suction hose to the 3/4" QDC connector located on the sprayer.


2.1 - Sprayer Assembly, continued

3. Take the bypass tube (F) and the 5' X 1/2" hose (G) that is supplied and fasten together. Put the bypass tube in the smaller hole of the barrel. Connect opposite end of the bypass hose to the 1/2" QDC connector located directly below the flow control valve.
4. Locate the spray wand hose (H). This hose will be the longer of the three. Connect one end to the spray wand (I) and the opposite end to the 1/2" QDC connector located on the 90 degree elbow below the flow control valve on the sprayer.

NOTE: Your sprayer and components may differ from the one shown in Fig. 2. This will depend on what model you order.

2.1.3 Assembly of Razorback® Power Sprayers to a Tow Cart.

1. After you have uncrated all components received, remove cotter key and washer (A). Slide out the pin in order to install the tow handle (B).
2. Next place the sprayer (C) on the tow cart (D). Use the fasteners provided to fasten the sprayer to the frame. If you are using a 9910 sprayer, place the sprayer to the front of the frame away from the barrel. If you are using a 6500, 7560, or a 7560XL sprayer, this process will not have to be done.
3. Take the reducer (E) and the 5' X 3/4" hose (F) that is supplied and fasten together. Connect that end to the larger hole on the barrel. Connect opposite end of suction hose to the 3/4" QDC connector located on the sprayer.
4. Take the 5' X 1/2" bypass hose (G) that is supplied and fasten to the smaller hole on the barrel. Connect opposite end of the bypass hose to the 1/2" QDC connector located directly below the flow control valve.
5. Locate the spray wand hose (H). This hose will be the longer of the three. Connect one end to the spray wand (I) and the opposite end to the 1/2" QDC connector located on the 90 degree elbow below the flow control valve on the sprayer.




SECTION 2 OPERATIONS

Proper Maintenance and Operation for Reducer, 9910 D30 Pump and Control Valve

1. When changing oil in the Reducer, remove the drain plug (A) located on the bottom of the Reducer. (refer to Fig. 1) After the oil has completely drained, replace drain plug(A) and tighten. To fill, remove side level plug (B) and vent plug (C). (refer to Fig. 1) Fill until the gear lube is no higher than the mark on the dipstick. After proper oil level has been obtained replace plugs.

USE 90W GEAR LUBE TO FILL GEAR CASE

2. Check oil level in pump daily. Be sure oil is halfway up to the clear oil sight tube (D). If it is not, fill to the correct level using a high-grade, non-detergent, SAE 30 weight oil. This will help prolong the pump life. (refer to Fig. 2)
3. Check the charge pressure (E) on the pulsation dampener before starting the pump. The pressure is checked with a standard automotive air gauge. The pressure should be at approximately 20% of the maximum operating pressure. (refer to Fig. 3)
4. On the pump you can adjust the pressure by clamping the relief valve adjustment lever (F) down. With the bale hook in the number one position the pressure is about 100 psi; number two is about 250 psi; number three is about 450 psi; number four is about 550 psi. These pressures can be adjusted by using the fine adjustment knob (G) located on top of the relief valve spring. The fine adjustment knob can be rotated when the relief valve lever is in the up position. (refer to Fig. 3)

Periodic Maintenance

The list below contains basic sprayer and engine maintenance. Refer to engine manufacturer's Operation Manual for additional information on engine maintenance. A copy of the engine Operator's Manual was supplied with the machine when it was shipped.

Check Fuel Level	Daily
Check Air Filter- Replace as needed	Daily
Check and Tighten External Hardware	Daily
Change Engine Oil	100 hrs.
Replace Spark Plug	300 hrs.

NOTE

All set screws have blue (LOC-TITE™) applied at the factory. If set screw is removed or loosened for any reason re-apply blue (LOC-TITE™).

NOTE

All grease fittings are capped with CAP PLUG GC-5 (AEC PN 015692) to protect the fitting. If cap becomes missing or damaged replace it as soon as possible.

NOTE

Anti-Seize is applied at the factory to all drive line coupling, gear box main and counter shafts and pitch control threaded rod assemblies. If these parts are disassembled re-apply a light coat of a graphite based anti-seize.

4. **DO NOT** return parts to AEC without receiving written authorization from AEC. All authorized returns must be shipped pre-paid.
5. When placing an order, please contact the AEC Dealer nearest you.


